
- **Returning participants**

# Before Spring Training Starts




- **Does your team want to play this year?**

# Spring Training: Day 1

- The day Connectathon registration opens
- You are trying to create your roster
- Step 1 (Gazelle):
  - Create account for your organization
  - Enter demographics for your org
  - Enter contact people (billing, marketing, technical)
  - **You can do this while deciding on your actors**


# Registration Process (2)



- **Step 2:**
    - While you are deciding what to test
    - Create one system
    - Register in the ITI Domain for CT (Consistent Time). Use the Time Client Actor.
    - Generate the contract so you can review terminology
    - **Do not send this in**
    - **Ask questions about registration process**


# Registration Process (3)



- **Step 3:**
    - Determine your final roster
    - Register all systems/actors/profiles in Gazelle
    - Generate contract/application
    - Sign contract/application
    - Submit contract/application + payment
    - **Contract/application + payment should reach sponsors on/before closing date**
- 

# After Registration Closes



- You cannot add systems
  - You cannot add actors
  - You cannot add profiles
  - You can ask me to delete systems, actors, profiles
  - Why can't I add an actor at the last minute?
    - Other participants have made allocations
    - Certainly you can project 3-4 months out
- 


# What Happens If ....



- **A profile does not have enough systems to test?**
  - At registration close, we publish a risk assessment
  - For profiles that clearly do not have enough, we remove registration and move on
  - For profiles that are marginal, we warn the group to pay heed

# How Many Systems?



- **Registration fees are based on system count + domain count**
  - **What is a system?**
    - **Loosely defined as a reasonable collection of actor/profile pairs that one would market as a product**
- 

# Is This One System?

- Fax, printer, copier, answering machine
  - So far, so good
- Coffee break chime
  - Maybe
- Espresso maker
  - No
- Refrigerator
  - NO!

# Fee Calculation

- **\$4500.00 / system**
- **\$4500.00 / domain**
- **Some domains will be free when you register for other domains**
- **Minimal charge is \$9000.00**


# Sample Calculation



<b>System 1</b>	<b>ITI + Radiology</b>	
<b>System 2</b>	<b>ITI + PCC</b>	
<b>Total Systems</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>\$ 9,000</b>
<b>Total Domains</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>\$ 9,000</b>
	<b>(ITI free with PCC)</b>	
<b>Total Fees</b>		<b>\$18,000</b>

# Spring Training is Over



- **You have set your roster**
    - Actor / profile pairs
  - **Everything after this is to support the Connectathon**
  - **Unlike baseball**
    - You cannot add to your roster
    - You cannot make trades
- 

# Connectathon??


- You register for actor A / profile P
  - Gazelle maps that to tests for that pair
  - Gazelle lists all possible partners for these tests
- You test at the Connectathon in a controlled environment
  - Use Gazelle to find a willing partner
  - Negotiate time to start testing
  - Test results reviewed by neutral monitors

# You Are Responsible



- For all required tests
  - To be proactive to find test partners
  - To get your work done
  - To cut off your arm
    - Drop an actor / profile pair
  - to save your body
    - Finish testing 3 actors rather than failing 4
-


