IHE 2010 NA Connectathon

- 498 system engineers...*who were testing*
- More than 150 health IT systems and 3,640 tests...*from*
- 104 participating companies/organizations
- HITSP Constructs tested nearly doubled at this year's IHE North America Connectathon with 43 HITSP Constructs, compared to 24 in 2009
- Number of IHE Profiles: Still gathering data, will post at a later time

HIMSS10 Badge Registration

Two Types of Badges:

1. **Exhibitor Badges:** Allow access into the exhibit floor one hour before and one hour after the conference exhibit floor is open.
 - All Showcase staff must an exhibitor badge!

2. **Full Conference Badges:** Allows access only during Exhibitor hours.





Connectathon Impact

- **Infrastructure Services Participants Confirmed**
 - Some “drops” but still 18 domains
- **No-Shows Dropped from Showcase**
 - Primarily newbie EMR systems
- **Minimal Showcase Scenario Testing Completed...**
 - Geneva configuration entries 98% completed
 - IHE Profile testing ran over into Friday morning
 - Scenarios re-structured to better fit system capabilities
 - Scenario clinical storylines assessed/corrected
 - Missing scenario steps, e.g. Imaging, documented and system participants assigned

 - Scenario Description
 - System Assignments into Casts
 - System Assignments to Infrastructure Domains
- **Planning and Discussion Document for VST**

Virtual Showcase Testing


