The Information Placement and Retrieval through the Nationwide Health Information Network (InfoPRN) is a medical logistics research project being developed through the United States Army Telemedicine and Advanced Technology Research Center (TATRC). Its goal is to ensure emergency responders have timely access to the data necessary to treat both military and civilian personnel during a mass casualty event coordinating across jurisdictional and organizational “boundaries.” During this demonstration, participants will learn how InfoPRN provides capabilities to exchange and share medical resource information between private and public organizations supporting healthcare through the Nationwide Health Information Network.
